



Troop Rules (as approved by the PLC 03/27/09):

- No prohibited substances, including tobacco.
- No cursing or name-calling.
- No fighting.
- Be on time to troop and PLC meetings. Arrive five minutes before you are expected.
- No sheath knives or folding knives larger than 4”.
- No liquid stoves.
- No personal electronics, cell phones, etc, at meetings or campouts.
- Class-A Uniforms are worn by scouts/scouters at all scouting activities and events unless told otherwise.
- With rare exception, youth leaders who miss two meetings/campouts in a given term will be dismissed from their positions. All scouts must notify the SPL or PL if they will be absent.
- Five un-excused absences from troop meetings, etc, results in being dropped from the roster and a meeting with the Scoutmaster is required to rejoin the troop.
- Violation of any rule may result in denial of next troop activity at the discretion of the SPL and Scoutmaster.
- Patrol Leaders and SPL may issue physical challenges, such as push-ups, extra camp duties, etc, for rules violations, after first notifying the SPL or ASPL.
- Scouts sleep with their patrols, not other patrols or parents (except in case of medical necessity).
